Description of Broadloom Carpet

The term rubber underlay is taken to mean sheet rubber supplied in roll format to be used as an underlay under wall – to -wall floor covering products.

Belgotex (NZ) Ltd supplies rubber underlay comprising of recycled rubber. Rubber underlay can be either laid loosely, with double sided tape, or adhesive and is supplier by linear meter, or full rolls.

When installed a Belgotex (NZ) Ltd rubber underlay may contribute to G6 (airborne & impact sound) of the building. Compliance with this clause would need to be established as part of the proposed flooring system.
