

SUSTAINABILITY

A LIGHT FOOTPRINT

Premium SDN manufacturing is a process with sustainability at its core. It includes a single-step spinning and colouring process, waterless and pollution free manufacturing, and high yields with low scrap.

GREENTAG CERTIFIED

Global GreenTag's LCRate scores products against six main Sustainability Assessment Criteria and a further twenty plus Life Cycle and Social Criteria. Our 6 Star certification recognises "World Leadership" at our factory for our sustainability practices in all aspects of plant and carpet manufacturing operations. We have also earned the Global GreenTag eco-label certification. This internationally recognised "Level A" Global GreenTag certification − called GreenRate™ − maximises our products eligibility to achieve 100% of the available credit points across all the Green Building Council (GBCSA) rating tools. The stringent assessment process has equipped us to develop holistically and entrench sustainability across our value chain.

GREENSTAR

CLEANING GUIDE

- The faster you act, the better the results.
- First, remove as much of the foreign material as possible: carefully scrape off thick or sticky material with a spoon, vacuum up crusty pieces if it is dry, or blot with a white paper towel if the stain is wet.
- Identify the stain and refer to the stain chart before you begin.
- Never scrub the stain.

VACUUM FREQUENTLY

- Thorough vacuuming removes dirt particles that dull the carpets appearance and cause fibre damage.
- Make sure your vacuum cleaner is in good working order; remember to change dust bags and clean filters regularly.
- Heavy traffic areas like stairs and corridors should be vacuumed daily.
- Vacuum cleaners should have 'high suction' and no beater brush.

PREVENT SOILING AND PILE DAMAGE

- Place walk-off mats at all entrances.
- Use carpet protectors under heavy furniture and furniture with castors.

ANNUAL PROFESSIONAL CLEAN

- When a carpet appears dirty even after vacuuming, it's time for a professional clean.
- Consult a professional cleaner for the best method of cleaning.
- An annual professional hot water extraction is required to retain your warranty.

STAIN REMOVAL TRICKS OF THE TRADE

- Always blot from the outside in to minimise the stain area.
- Never use any of the solutions in concentrations stronger than recommended and always follow manufacturer's instructions.
- Use acetone and dry-cleaning fluid in ventilated conditions only.
- Pet "accidents" and certain other stains may reappear, as a result of "wicking". If, after
 repeating the stain removal procedure, the stain continues to reappear, contact a
 professional carpet cleaner for assistance. Note: Please remove urine stains as soon as
 possible. This warranty does not cover stains that have not been dealt with immediately,
 and have permeated the backing of the product.
- If a stain cannot be identified or is not listed in this guide, first use Procedure 1. If the stain shows no sign of being removed, try Procedure 2.
- Some harsh stains may require the procedure to be repeated several times.

STAIN REMOVAL METHOD

- Mix a solution of equal parts bleach and water in a spray bottle.
- Use household bleach containing no additives.
- Perfumed bleach may be used.
- Remove as much of the stain as possible by blotting or scraping up.
- Spray the solution directly onto the carpet.
- Do not soak.
- Blot the surface of the carpet, working from the outside of the stain to the centre. Repeat until the stain disappears.
- Spray with water and blot until the bleach has been removed.
- To absorb any remaining moisture, use folded paper towels weighted with a heavy non-staining object.
- When completely dry, vacuum to restore the pile texture.

ACETONE METHOD

- Remove as much of the stain as possible by blotting or scraping up.
- Apply a small amount of pure acetone to a cloth working in gently.
- Do not soak.
- Blot the surface of the carpet, working from the outside of the stain to the centre. Repeat until the stain disappears.
- To absorb any remaining moisture, use folded paper towels weighted down with a heavy non-staining object.
- When completely dry, vacuum to restore the pile texture.

Stain Removal Tip: Wicking is when after being cleaned a stain travels from the base of the carpet to the tip, reappearing. If this problem persists, contact a professional carpet cleaner.
