# Impact Tiles

## **Product Overview**

Standard Impact-Tiles are manufactured in 1 metre x 1 metre size, in various thicknesses, with top bevelled edges around the perimeter. The individual weight of the thicker tiles make them perfect for loose laid installations thereby eliminating adhesive costs and significantly reducing labour. This makes good sense for the fitness centre owners who can treat the floor as an asset which is removable if relocation is required.

Impact-Tiles are mass produced so a simple range of colours are available with custom colours available upon request. Standard colours are a black base with either grey, blue or red coloured flecks or straight black.
